We are very pleased to invite you to the 10th International Conference "The Biology of Plant Cells in vitro and Biotechnology". It will take place October 14-18, 2013 in Kazan, one of the largest and most beautiful cities of the Volga region.

Since 1968, a series of "The Biology of Plant Cell in vitro and Biotechnology" meetings have been held every five years in various parts of the Soviet Union and then in Russian Federation. The previous conferences were successfully held in Moscow, Kiev, Yerevan, Chisinau, Novosibirsk, Alma-Ata, Moscow, Saratov and Zvenigorod.

Main topics of the Conference are:

- 1. Physiological, biochemical, genetic, cytological and molecular biology features of plant cell cultures;
- 2. Regulation of plant cell morphogenesis in vitro;
- 3. Plant cell culture as a model system for studying the basic mechanisms of fundamental cellular events;
- 4. Genetically transformed plant cells, organs and plants;
- 5. Collections of plant cell and tissue cultures; the methods of gene pool preservation;
- 6. Application of plant cell cultures in industry biotechnology;
- 7. Application of plant cell cultures in agricultural biotechnology.

To facilitate the communication between participants at the Conference, we are planning to publish a booklet with additional information about the participants. To do this, we kindly ask you to send a file with a color photo portrait (photo_surname.jpg) and indicate direction(s) of your research and your methods and approaches used (research-methods_surname.doc).

Rules for authors

The abstract should be written in English. The text should be laid out for standard A4 (portrait format) paper. Font size should be 12pt, text font Times New Roman, width alignment, 1 line spacing. The abstract text should not exceed 1 page A4 with fields of 2 cm. You can download the guidelines for abstract submission and the example of abstract on web-site of the Conference.

The abstract should be sent as an attached file by e-mail to Sibgatullina Guzel <u>(invitro2013@gmail.com)</u> until the 1st May, 2013. Only electronic versions of the abstracts are accepted. The abstracts will be reproduced without any editing.

The file should be titled: surname_inicials_absteng (for instance, smith_a_t_absteng). If you send several abstracts, you must put the number after the last letter of title (for instance, smith_a_t_abst1 and smith_a_t_abst2). All abstracts should be sent as separate files.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to decline incorrectly arranged abstracts and the ones which do not correspond to the topics of the conference. We will send you e-mail message with the confirmation of admission or rejection of your abstracts in 15 days after receiving your abstracts. If your abstract is accepted, you must pay the registration fee no later than June 1, 2013 to be included in the Conference presentation schedule.

Simultaneously with the publication of abstracts, we are planning to publish proceedings of the Conference.

Participants interested in publication of the article should send us both abstract and an article. The article should be prepared according to <u>the rules of The Russian Journal of</u> <u>Plant Physiology</u> and should not exceed 6 pages.

The file should be titled: surname_inicials_publ (for instance: smith_a_t_publ).

Publication charge for article is 10\$ per page.
